This qualitative research observes complications and difficulties in detail for every project. It accounts in identifying problematic areas, at the same time, provides division alternatives to the Concession authority.

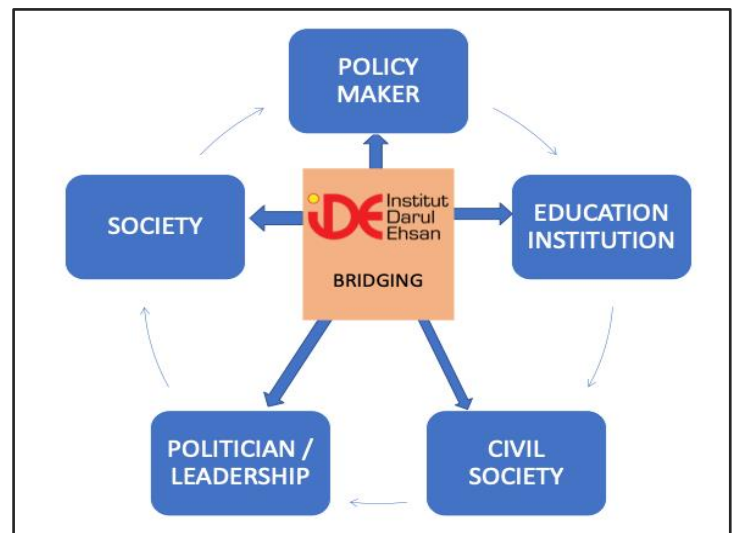
This survey aims to avoid dissent as minimum as possible to parties who are involve both directly or indirectly to the research (residents, consumers, land owners, local authority).

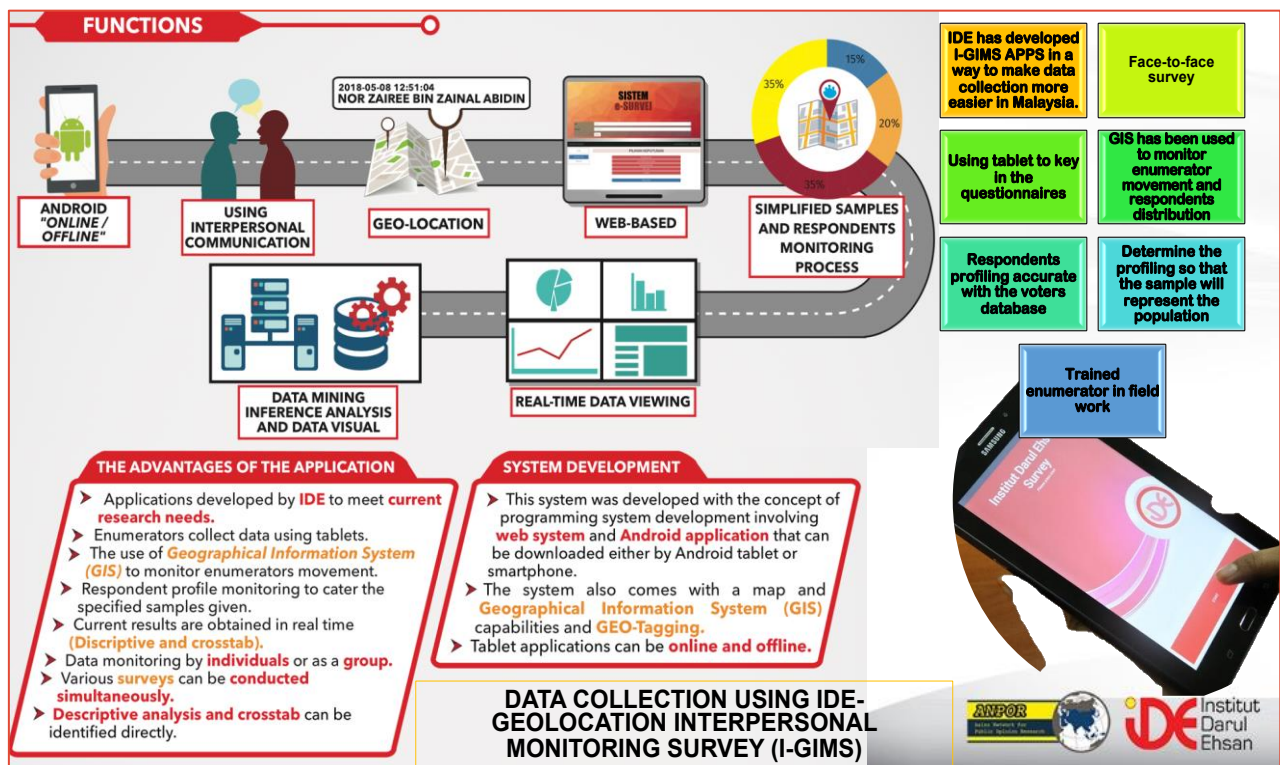


RESEARCH METHODS

In public opinion or perception research, two primary methods are employed for data collection: survey questionnaires and focus group interviews (FGIs). Given the diverse demographics of the Malaysian population targeted for this study, a survey offers a comprehensive approach to delve into people's responses and gather in-depth insights. Consequently, the current research will utilize a survey method, employing a questionnaire as the primary instrument for data collection.

Trained enumerators will be engaged to administer the survey through face-to-face interviews. Each enumerator will utilize a tablet device provided by IDE, equipped with the I-GIMS Software, as illustrated in Figure 1, to gather and manage the data efficiently.

The research draws upon data from three primary sources: the Malaysian Department of Statistics (DOSM) 2020, the Malaysian Electoral Roll 2020, and the IDE-SPERA Database. These sources collectively provide a robust foundation for the study's data analysis and interpretation.

Beyond the reliability of the sample size derived from these reputable sources, the research methodology's strength lies in its innovative data collection technique, developed by IDE in the form of the IDE-Geolocation Interpersonal Monitoring Survey (I-GIMS) software. Serving as the cornerstone of the survey, this software facilitates efficient data collection and management. The images below illustrate the fieldwork process and data gathering activities conducted by the enumerators.

Complementing the survey method is the use of focus group interviews, a qualitative approach designed to elicit rich descriptions of individuals' perspectives and understanding of the research issues. These interviews will be conducted by experienced researchers with diverse expertise in various research domains.


RESEARCH INNOVATION

The backbone software for conducting the survey will be the **IDE-Geolocation Interpersonal Monitoring Survey (I-GIMS)**.







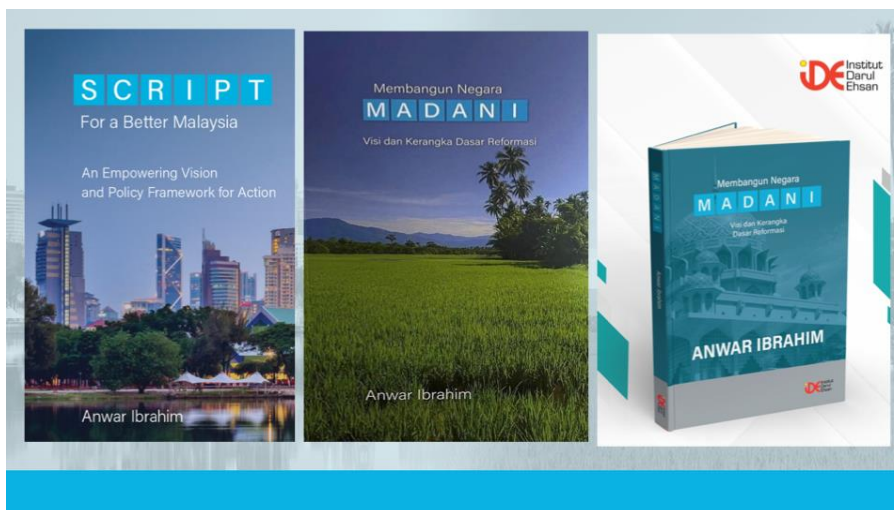
ENLIGHTENMENT PROGRAMME FOR SOCIETY

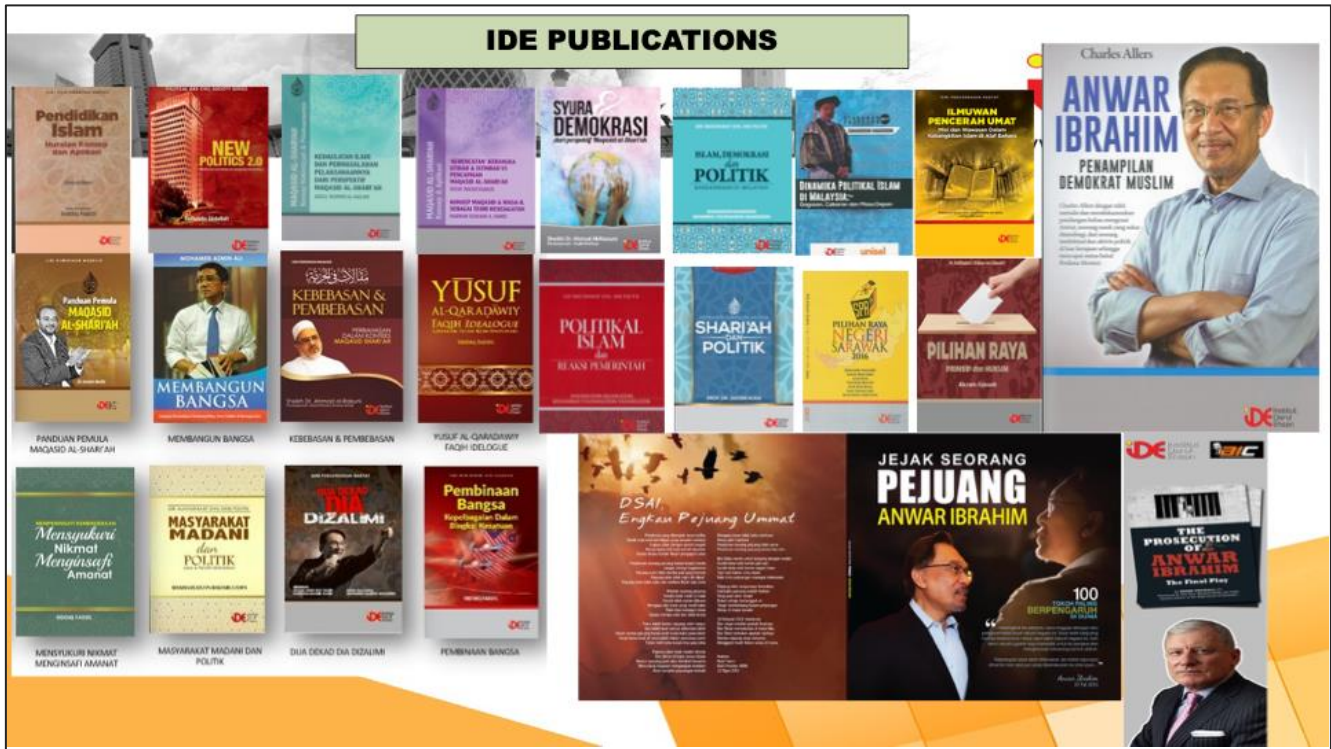
Furthermore, IDE established the **Nation Building Centre** on September 13, 2017, with the following objectives:
